



## Bobble Crochet Pattern

This bobble pattern measures 9 x 6 inches. It's made length-wise.

Chain 25 with an I hook with worsted-weight yarn. You will do 13 rows in total.

Stitches Used:

- ✓ Half Double Crochet
- ✓ MB (Make Bobble)

The bobble is done with 4 “open ended” Double Crochets so.... YO, insert hook in next st, YO, pull up a loop, YO, pull through two loops, (YO, insert hook in same st, YO, pull up a loop, YO, pull through two loops) 3 times, then you'll have 5 loops on hook, YO and draw through all loops on hook

If your bobble isn't as *pronounced* as you would like it you can do a single crochet after each bobble. It makes a tighter fit. Also, when doing the bobble it will be shown on the opposite side that you're crocheting on. You crochet it on the wrong side and it is shown on the right side.

### Pattern:

Row 1: Do 1 Hdc in third chain from hook, and do 1 Hdc in each stitch across the row (23 Hdc's)

Row 2, 6, 10, 13: chain 2 turn, do 1 Hdc in each stitch across the row

Row 3, 7, 11: chain 2 turn, \*Do 1 Hdc in the first 3 stitches, MB\* repeat \*-\* and end with MB and the 3 Hdc's (4 bobbles)

Row 4, 8, 12: chain 2 turn, do 1 Hdc in each stitch across the row

Row 5, 9: chain 2 turn, Do 1 Hdc in the first 5 stitches, MB, \*1 Hdc in each of the next 3 stitches, MB\* repeat \*-\* and end with 5HDC's

The pattern repeats rows 2-5 but I wanted 2 rows of Half Double Crochets at the beginning and at the end.
