$$x = 200$$

$$\text{Price of 1 Chair} = 200$$

$$\text{Price of 1 Table} = 500$$

$$\text{Price of 12 chairs} = 200 \times 12$$

$$= 2400$$

$$\text{Price of 3 tables} = 3 \times 500$$

$$= 1500$$

$$\text{Total price} = 2400 + 1500$$

$$= 3900$$
